

### **Game instruction**

Pour all yellow and green balls into the storage container. Then draw a card with a password. Decipher the letters of the password in any order. After identifying each letter, find the corresponding ball and place it on a stand. Before starting, draw a “handedness” card. Throughout the task – searching for balls and arranging them on stands – use only the indicated hand.

### **Game objective:**

Decipher the password using the rule that each number corresponds to a letter’s position in the English alphabet.

### **Materials needed:**

- yellow and green mini-Eduball balls,
- ball storage container,
- ball stands (as many as there are letters in the password),
- password cards,
- “handedness” cards.
